
PE

Homework will be sent home on Thursdays and is due back the following Tuesday.


Spellings will be sent home on Thursday and tested on Tuesday. Times tables will be tested on Tuesday later in the term. Please check homework for details.



Art

What are God's rules for living? We will learn about how the ten commandments help Christians in their Where is the Light of Christmas? Our Christmas unit will focus on the light of Christmas, and Jesus as the light of the world. Children will also write recounts and do artwork linked to Christmas and the Nativity story. Florence Nightingale - We will be examining her life and influence on nursing and the progression of medicine. We will be visiting the Florence Nightingale Museum as part of our work on this topic. Great Fire Of London - We will start to think about when and where the fire happened, how it started, and the importance of eye-witnesses. Australia - different areas of Australia, physical features, Aboriginal Australia and Australian animals. We will be comparing these features to areas in the UK. Locational Language and Geographical Skills - naming and locating seven continents and countries in the UK. Using simple compass directions and location and directional language. Our PSHE week takes place during the week commencing Monday 30th September 2019 and will focus on positive relationships (including antibullying) and celebrating diversity. In Year 2 we will be learning about ourselves and others, celebrating differences, and how things we do can have an effect on other people. Our focus in PE this term is on ball skills, working collectively as a team, using large and small ball skills in team games, learning different game strategies and developing our communication skills. We will be designing and making our own instruments with friends. We will also be exploring sounds and how sounds are made before bringing all our research together in our new creations. To finish the topic, we will be playing them together as a brand new orchestra! Children will do a range of pieces using different materials and techniques, including linked to our topic on Australia. We will also be creating artwork inspired by our local area for our Arts Project this term. We will be linking DT to some of our topics this term - planning, creating Design and evaluating projects.
