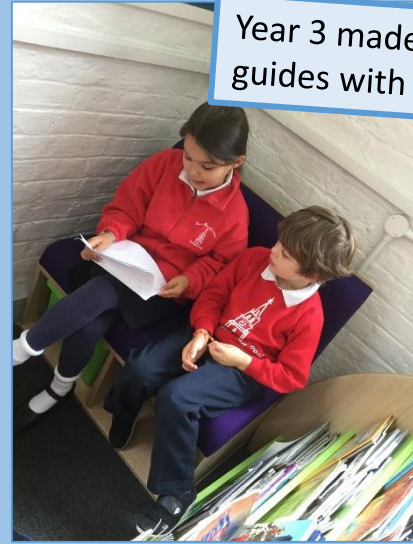


Building positive relationships

Be respectful, be a good role-model!



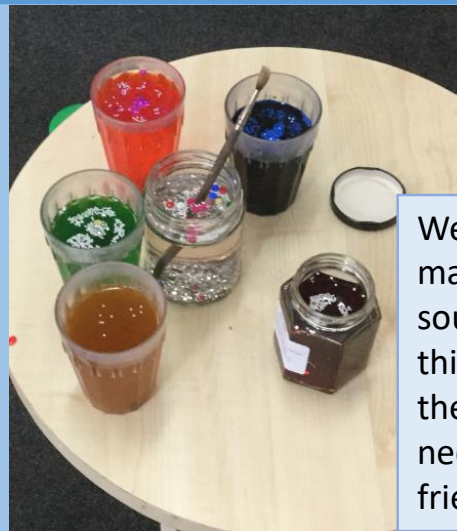
Year 3 made and shared some friendship guides with Year 1.
