### PE


### Class assembly

## Christ Church Arts Project (CAP)

Each class will create a film this term with the majority of them centring around our school Christian vision and values. Details of the premiere to follow soon!



English will be taught through a range of genres this term. We will begin by looking at Adventure Stories, where we will read the Hodgeheg by Dick King Smith and base our work around this text. We will also look at Information Texts and Performance Poetry.



We will be covering a range of topics:

- Place Value and Sequences
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Shape and Symmetry
- Fractions
- Measurements
- Problem Solving
- Time and Data



Later this term we will begin some science units, with the majority taking place in the summer term. The learning covered this term will focus on 'Plants' and 'Light'.



This term, we will visit the CLC for the day to learn about coding by programming LEGO! This is a fantastic opportunity for the children to put their skills into practice and learn new skills. We will also look at eSafety and create an information leaflet linking to our topic on Light.



RE

This term we will begin by learning all about the Contemporary Anglican Church. We will then focus on a World Faith for the main part of the spring term. In year 3 we will be learning about Islam. We will learn about the key aspects of the religion and consider the differences and similarities between Islam and Christianity. This will include a visit to Regent's Park Mosque. Towards the end of term, we will be focusing on the Easter story, thinking about who the most important person in the story is.

History



To begin with, we will continue to look at Ancient Egypt. We will then move onto our next topic: 'A History of Our Local Area'. We will visit Burgh House to learn about the history of Hampstead and how it has changed over time. This will also link to our Geography work as we will be identifying the human and physical features of Hampstead.

Geography



In geography this term, we will be continuing to investigate human and physical geography of the South East region of the UK, including London. We will think about topics like cliff erosion, the uses of the River Thames and the history of the London Underground. Our geography work will also link to our history topic on Hampstead.

PSHE



Our PSHE week takes place during the week commencing Monday 4<sup>th</sup> February 2019 and will be focused on keeping healthy and safe. In Year 3 we will be learning about the Eat Well Guide, designing our own healthy menus, learning about how germs spread and much more!

PE



PE this term will be taught by Mr Spadaccini. The children will focus on health and fitness initially, thinking about how exercise can keep our bodies healthy. They will then look at cricket, learning the basic rules of the game and developing their throwing and catching skills.

Music



The children will be exploring sounds in 'communication', exploring beat, metre and rhythm in 'time' and exploring structure in 'ancient worlds'. We will also be preparing for our Performing Arts Assembly and the children will also continue to learn how to play the recorder.

Art



We will be making our own pyramids as part of our continuing history topic on Ancient Egypt and then mixing sand with paint to create a textured surface. We will also create symmetrical Islamic patterns when we study Islamic art as part of our world faith topic.

Design  
Technology

In DT we will be designing and creating our own theatre puppets and light boxes as part of our science topic and weaving Islamic prayer mats as part of our world faith topic on Islam.
