

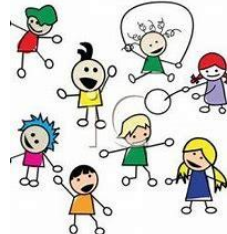
General Information and Reminders

Homework

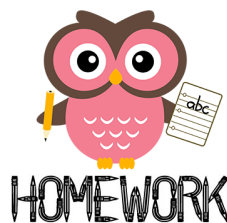
Homework will be sent home on Thursdays and is due back the following Tuesday.

Reminders

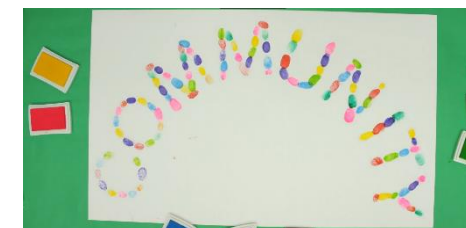
- Please ensure all school clothes are named to prevent items getting lost.

English



In literacy this term, we will spend the first half on the term working on our reading and grammar in preparation for exams. Following this, we will move onto more exciting writing pieces, which will be predominantly around one text.

Maths



We will be covering a range of topics:

- Place value and Number
- Data handling
- Shape and Space
- Measure

Also this term, we are going to be doing an exciting enterprise project where we will be setting up businesses.

RE



In R.E this term our big question is, "Who decides?"

Through this unit, we will consider the implications of rules and responsibilities for belonging to communities and in particular of belonging to a faith community. As a class, we will consider the rules in religions and other sources of authority. We will discuss rules, laws and responsibilities in society and in Christianity, Islam and Judaism

Science



We will finish our topic on the human body this term. We will then move onto learning about classification, micro-organisms and identification. Following that, we will learn about evolution- the story of Mary Anning and how fossils are formed. Later this term we will be learning about light and electricity- studying how light travels; which surfaces are most reflective; and creating circuits. We will be linking a lot of writing this term to our science learning.

Computing



We will be using computing to support other subjects across the curriculum, such as accounting in Excel for our businesses in maths and for publishing work in English and Science.

PSHE



Our PSHE week takes place during the week commencing Monday 10th June 2019 and is focused on The Wider Community. In Year 6, we will be learning about careers which will involve the careers morning. This also links with our enterprise projects.

PE



In P.E this term with Mr Spadaccini, we will be learning about athletics: long jump, triple jump, javelin throws, relays and training for the trials, which are being held on Tuesday 4th June. After athletics, we will be learning about striking and fielding.

Music



Music will be taught by Mr Pegden. The class will be working very hard to rehearse and perform songs for our summer end of year production. Mr Pegden will help with some of the staging for the show too.

Art



Art will be taught across the curriculum. This will be a combination of illustration to support our learning and mixed media. We will also be designing and painting our backdrops for the production.

Design Technology

In D&T we will be creating water filtration systems which will link to our courageous advocacy, thinking about how we can promote awareness of people around the world who need clean, fresh water.
