We explored the style of Pointillism and tried to recreate the beautiful colours of the Autumn leaves first by using cotton buds and then our fingers. The next step was the create a water colour wash for the hazy, blue sky. To recreate the texture of bark children learnt a technique using cardboard to scrape different coloured paints. The final step in the process was to think about the composition of the trees and arrange them in the foreground and background.
