

Trip to the Tate Britain Year 4 November 2019



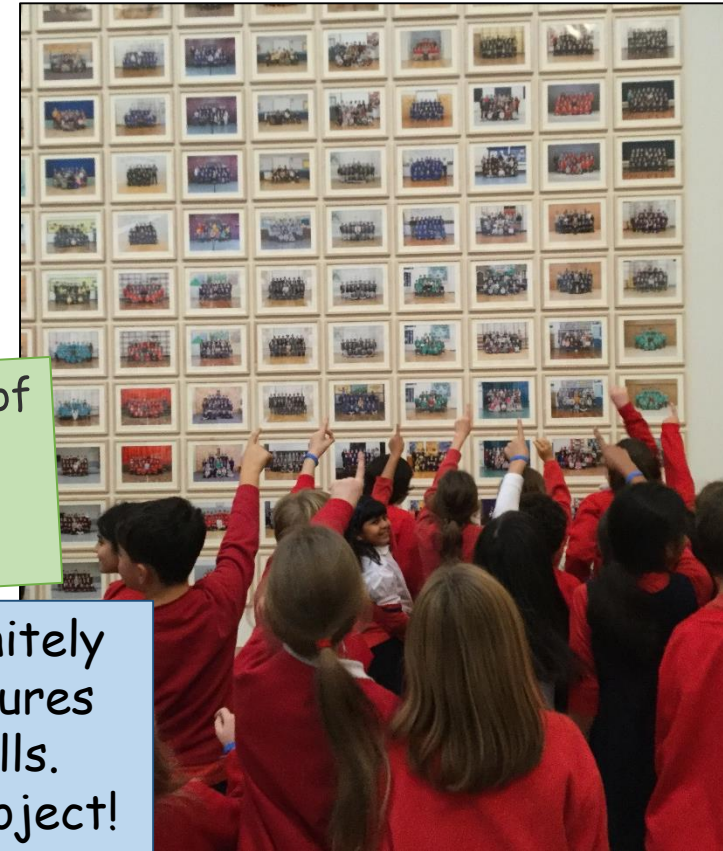
We got to see our photograph on a large screen before we entered the gallery. Some of us look very different now!
