Explanations/Hints and tips

Overview of weeks 1 to 4

Words containing the letter-string **ough**. This letter-string can be one of the trickiest spellings because it can be used to spell a number of different sounds. In the lists, you may find that a few of the different sounds related to this letter-string may be contained within one list.

Week 1

The /aw/ sound spelt **ough**

Week 2

The /uh/f/ sounds spelt **ough** (not in bold italics)

The /oh/ sound spelt **ough** (in bold italics)

Week 3

The /u/ sound spelt **ough** (the first set in italics)

The /ow/ sound spelt **ough** (not in bold italics)

The /o/f/ sounds spelt **ough** (the second set of bold italics)
