Apple math

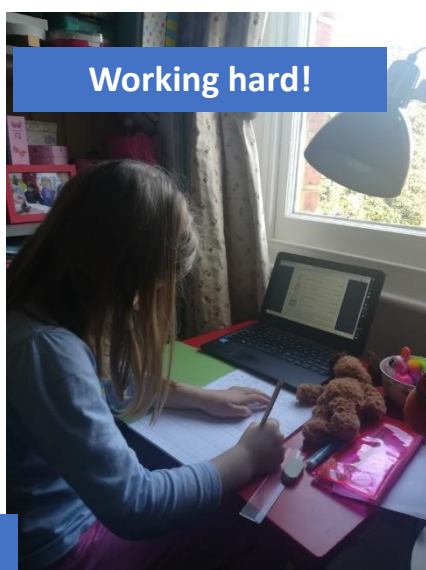
You will need:

Children use a 1-100 number square to help them add each pair of two-digit numbers.

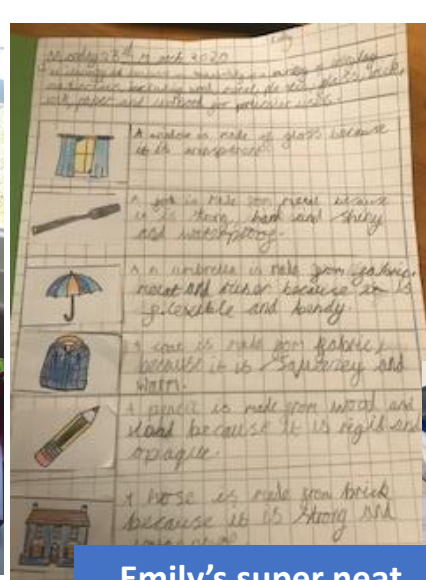
14 + 25 = 39

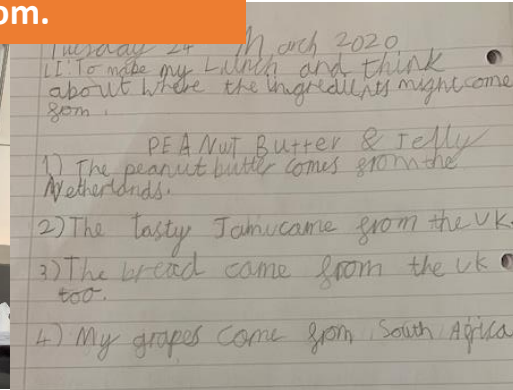
