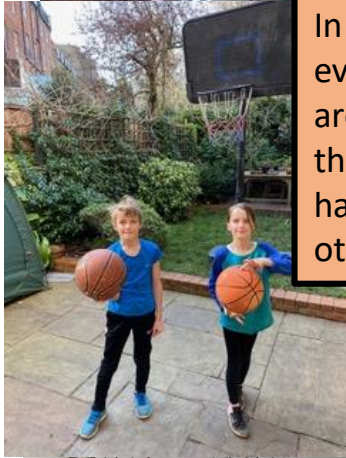


One member of Year 5 celebrated his birthday this week. Happy Birthday!
