

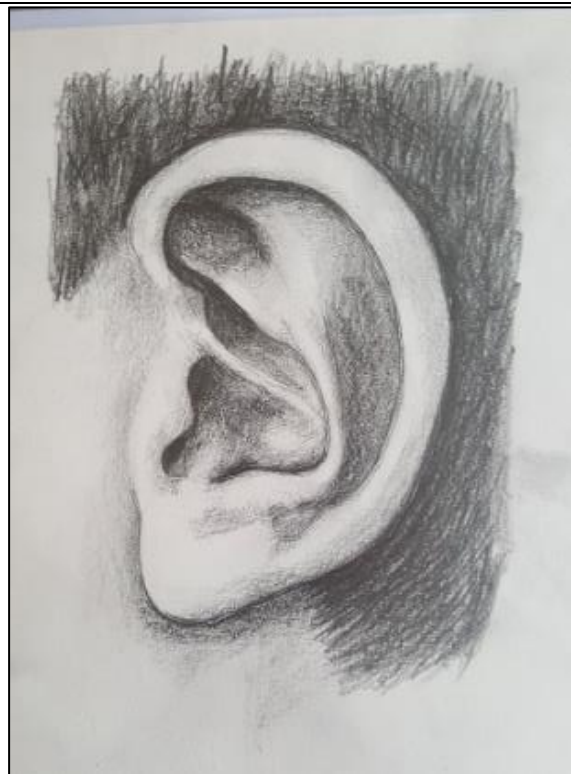

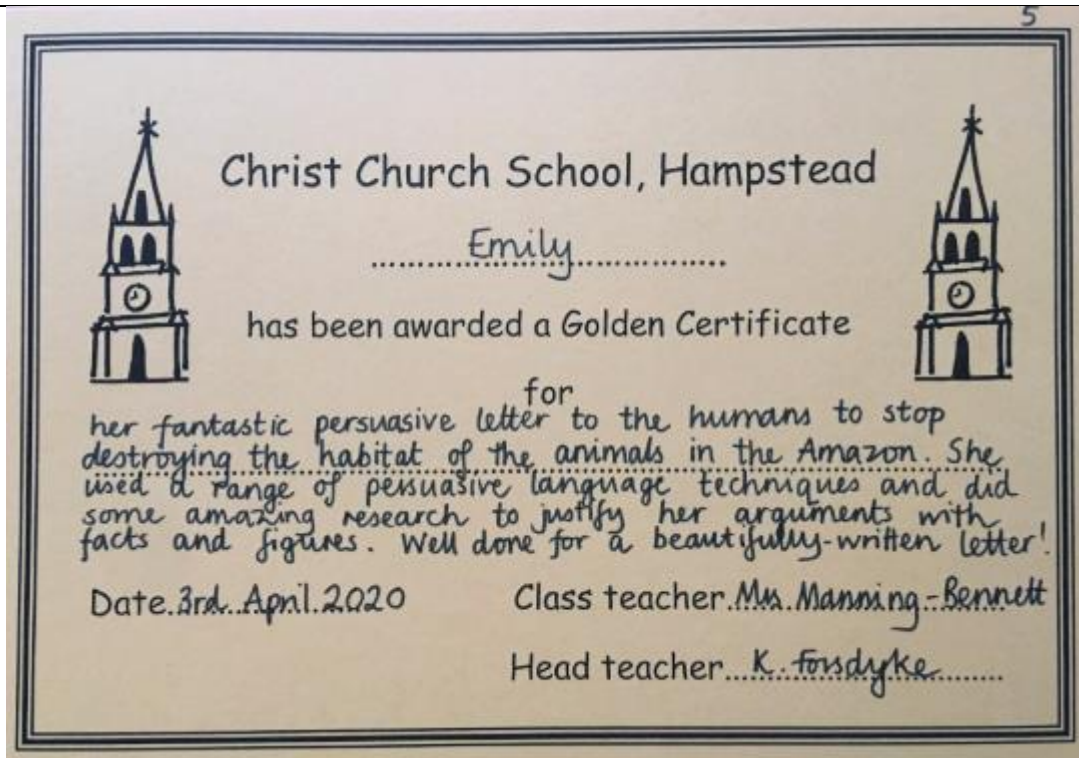

3. How do we know we are friends?

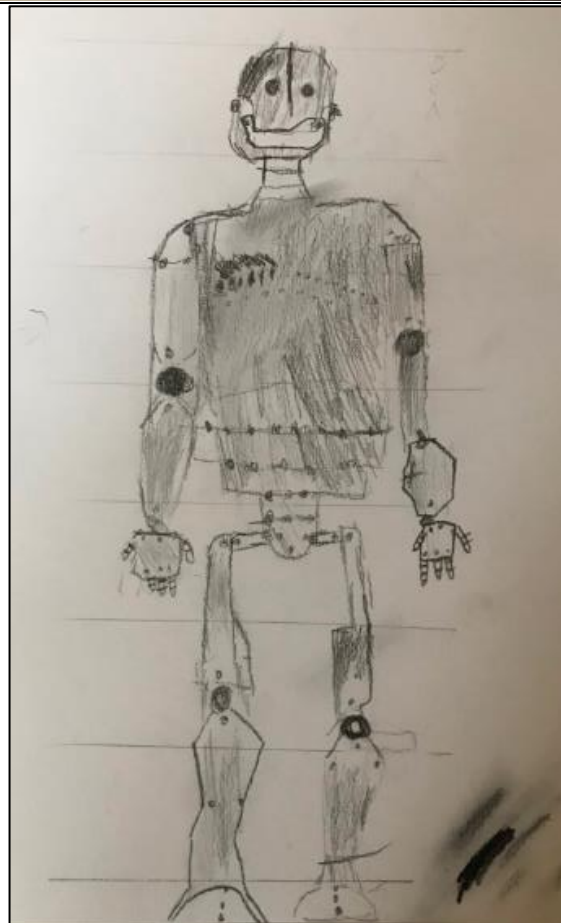
