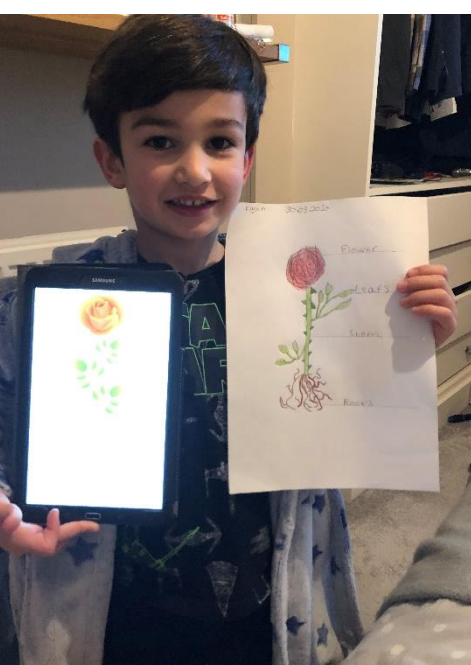


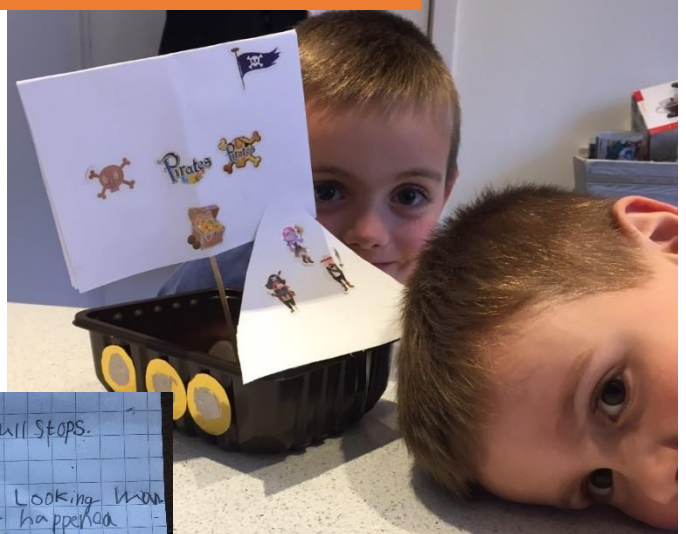
Year 1 have been decorating eggs boxes and other containers ready for some seeds to be planted in them next week!
