Chicken Quesadilla Recipe

Ingredients

- ginger

Method

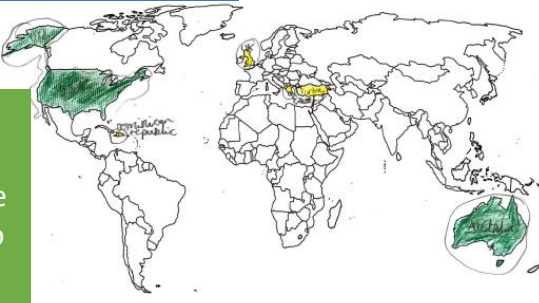
- Put a chicken in a big pot, add water and then add onion and ginger.

We wrote recipes/instructions for making our lunches the other day. Then we thought about where in the world the ingredients came from.

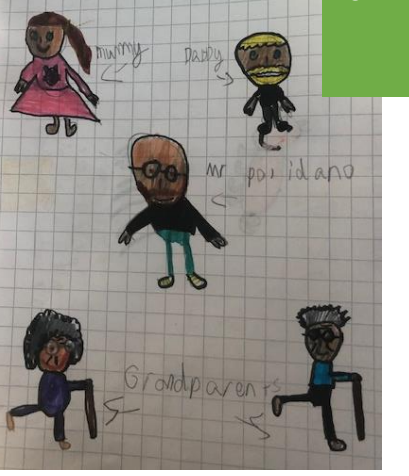


World Map Outline

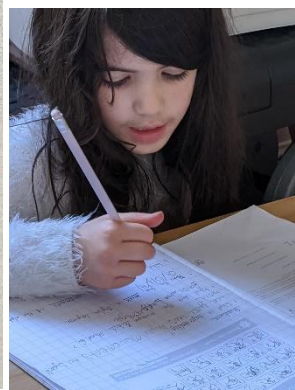
