Name of animal: Cat!
 Drawing or picture of its skull and teeth:

Function of teeth:
 Helps the cat hunt, kill and eat their prey. They are also an aid to self-defence and a tool for grooming. The small cat teeth (called incisors) aren't much use when hunting, they also help the cat pick out what it wants to eat.

Interesting fact:
 A kitten's age can be depending on their teeth!

Did you know?
 Did you know that cats cannot chew on their food! Cats have 30 adult teeth and 26 baby teeth. It is not normal for cats to lose any teeth! Cats could still survive with no teeth! They can also still eat when they have no teeth! Cats rarely show dental pain. You can brush their teeth!
