We use the word **because** to join two sentences. The second sentence explains the first sentence.

The girl went to bed **because** she was tired.
The boy ate the cake **because** he was hungry.
The boy ate the cake **because** it was his birthday.

Using if
We use the word **if** to connect two sentences. The second sentence depends on the first sentence.

You can play outside today **if** it is sunny.

We will go to the park after school **if** there is time.

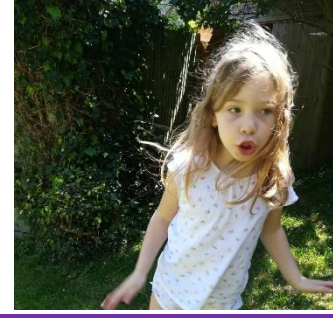
