 My favourite place is India because I like to enjoy my family and I like the beaches, the mountains and the nature and music are

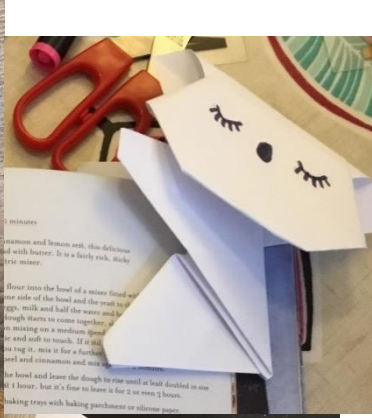
