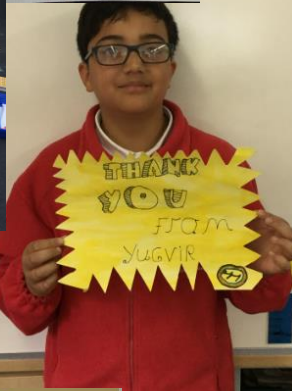
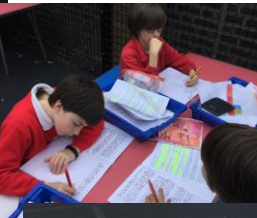
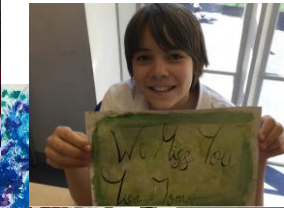


# Year 6 Home and School week 15.6.20
