Explanations/Hints and tips

Week 1

Words ending with **-ion**.

If the root word ends in **t** or **te**, the ending is usually **-tion**. This is the most common spelling.

Week 2

Words ending with **-ion**.

If the root word ends in **ss** or **mit**, the ending is usually **-ssion**.

Week 3

Words ending with **-ion**.

If the root word ends in **se** or **d**, the ending is usually **-sion**.

Exceptions being: attend - attention, intend - intention

Week 4

Words endings with **-ion**.

If the root word ends in **-de**. The **-de** is lost and **-sion** is added

Week 5

Words ending with **-cian**. (For many of these words there is a root word ending in **c** or **cs**)

These words area usually job related.
