Explanations/Hints and tips

Week 1

Words ending with -ion.

If the root word ends in t or te, the ending is usually -tion. This is the most common spelling.

Week 2

Words ending with -ion.

If the root word ends in ss or mit, the ending is usually -ssion.

Week 3

Words ending with -ion.

If the root word ends in **se** or **d**, the ending is usually -**sion**.

Exceptions being: attend - attention, intend - intention

Week 4

Words endings with -ion.

If the root word ends in -de. The -de is lost and -sion is added

Week 5

Words ending with -cian. (For many of these words there is a root word ending in c or cs) These words area usually job related.
