### Explanations/Hints and tips

#### Week 1

**Alternative prefixes** meaning 'not'

(many words add the prefix **in** to make the opposite meaning, but these words add a different prefix)

Children should know how to spell the word which has the opposite to each of the root words (adding prefix il, ir, im).
