Explanations/Hints and tips

<u>Week 1 - Homophones and other words that are often confused</u> Look up the two meanings if you don't know them!

Week 2 and Week 3 - homophone meanings

The meaning test will involve the children being supplied with a mixture of the homophone words from this half term **and last half term**. They will then write either the meaning of the word or use the word in the correct context to show they can differentiate between the different meanings and spellings.

Week 4 - Use of the hyphen

Hyphens can be used to join a prefix to a root word, especially if the prefix ends in a vowel letter and the root word also begins with one. However, some can be written without the hyphen as an alternate spelling.

Week 5 - spelling challenge
