

Religious Education this term

The whole school have been learning about different aspects of Christianity. Here is some of what they have been up to.



Year 3 have been asking 'How Did Belief In God Affect The Actions of People In The Old Testament?' They had fun creating a 'conscience alley' where Ruth passed down the alley and was advised on whether to stay with Naomi or return to her own family.



Reception have been investigating 'Who made the world wonderful and why?' They thought about what is precious to them and brought in some things that are special to them to share with the class. They have also made some creation pin wheels.

Year 1 have been thinking about why Christians make and keep promises before God. They learnt about how baptism is a ceremony whereby someone makes a commitment or promise to follow Jesus' word. When Jesus was baptised God sent the Holy Spirit to rest on Jesus' shoulder in the form of a dove. God was proud of his son for following him. Year 1 each made a dove and thought about a time when someone was proud of them.



Year 6 used designs to create a class set of stained glass windows that help tell the metanarrative or 'Big Story' of the Bible. The key parts they picked out were God, Creation, People of God, Incarnation, Salvation and Kingdom of God.



Year 5 have considered how the teachings of Jesus' miracles impact the way a Christian lives their life. They acted out one of Jesus' miracles then thought about how each of the characters would have felt at the time and whether it would have impacted the future choices they made.
