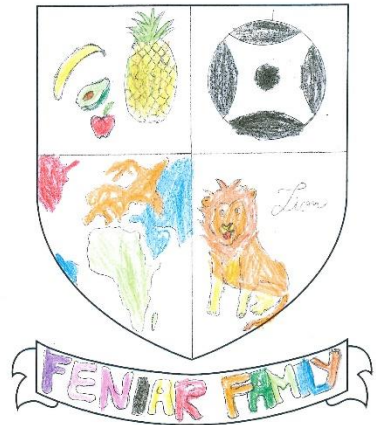

Talk with your parents and siblings to think about what makes your family unique and special. Create your own family crest, including things that are important to you and your family.

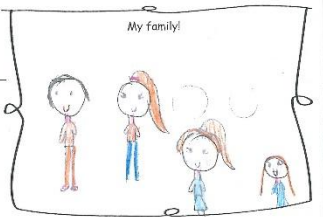


Year 2 PSHE week

Ruby Bridges Fact File



When was Ruby Bridges born?
9th September 1954

Ruby Bridges is significant because She was the first black woman to go to a white school. A police chief took her there so that she couldn't get scared because people were yelling and throwing things at her just because she was going to enter an only white school.
