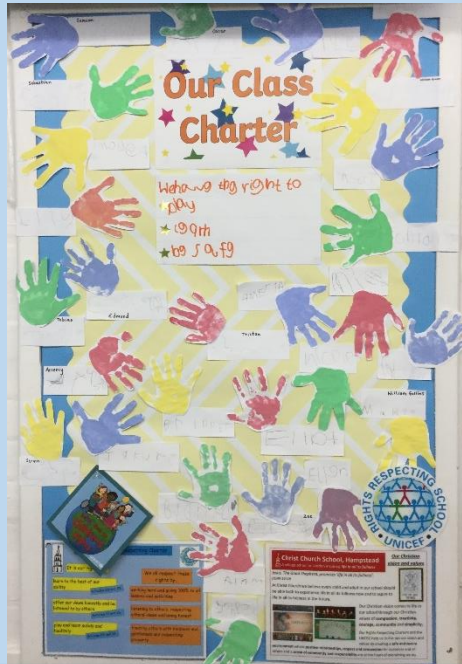


Reception's art project

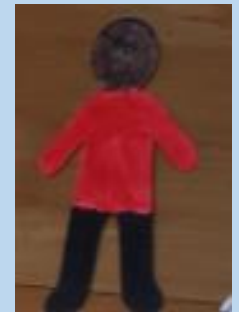
