

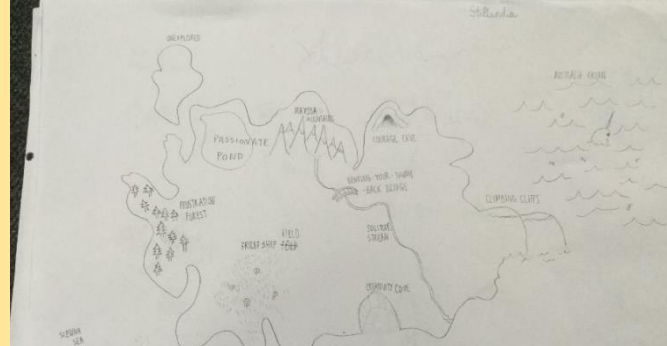

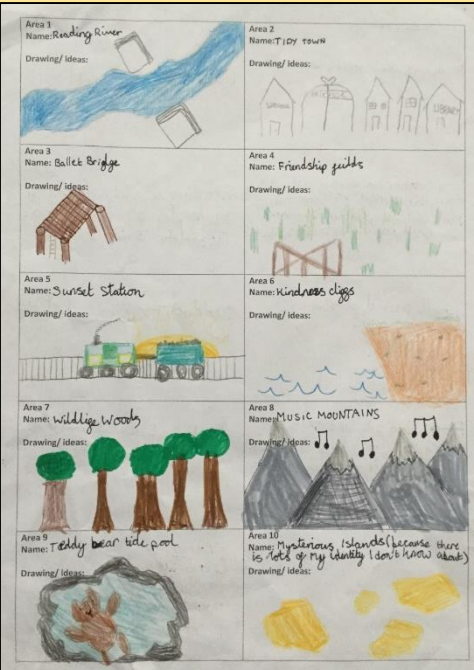
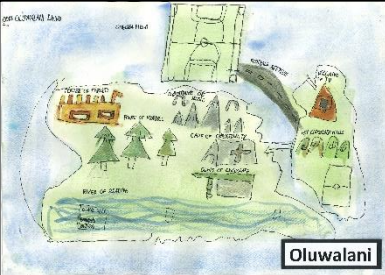
UNCRC Article 8: Protection and preservation of identity
