
## Year 4 Whole class artwork






In Year 4, we learnt about Global Goal 14: Life below water. We chose to focus on 14.1: reduce marine pollution. We learnt about why our oceans are important and about some of the threats that are currently facing them. We looked particularly at plastic pollution and the devastating impact this is having on marine wildlife.



We looked at some work by the artist, Robert Wyland, who paints large murals of underwater scenes.






We learnt how to use tracing paper to trace images.



We followed an online tutorial to sketch an image of a crab. We watched carefully as the artist completed each step.



We each created a watercolour image of our chosen marine animal. We also created watercolour images of plastic waste, such as bottles, drinks cups and plastic bags. We kept these items at the same scale as our wildlife to replicate the large amount of plastic waste currently in our oceans. We also added some real examples of waste.
