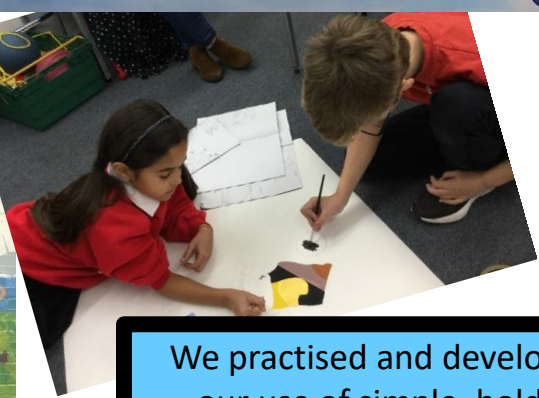
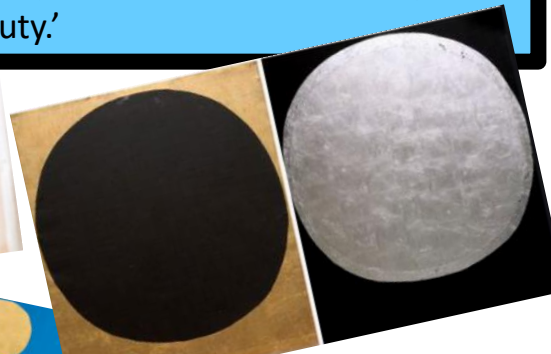
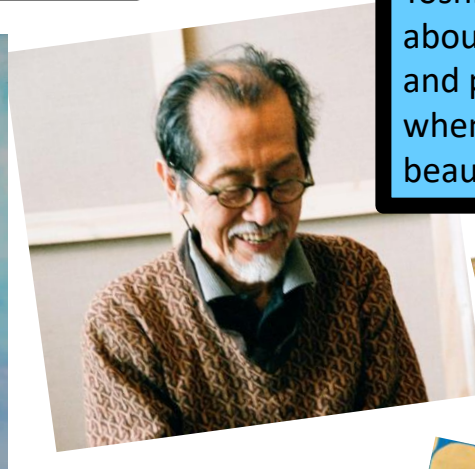


Year 5



Our whole class artwork was inspired by the Japanese artist and naval airman Kenji Yoshida, who created artwork to promote peace and life. Yoshida stated, 'I paint to tell people about the critical importance of life and peace. Life brightens the most when peace occurs. Peace is supreme beauty.'

In Year 5, we have been learning about UN Global Sustainability Goal 16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions. This goal aims to promote peaceful and inclusive societies for sustainable development, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable and inclusive institutions at all levels. We decided to focus specifically on target 16.12: promote and enforce non-discriminatory laws and policies for sustainable development.



We practised and developed our sketching skills and our use of simple, bold shapes to create abstract images that we felt represented peace. Once we had decided on our design, we merged them to create a whole class image of a dove and a gavel to link our work to our Global Sustainability Goal.
