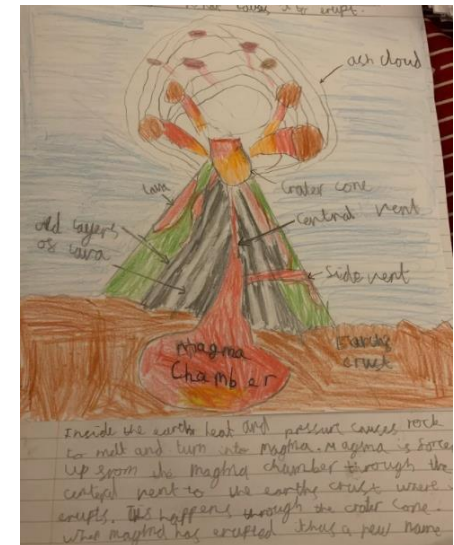
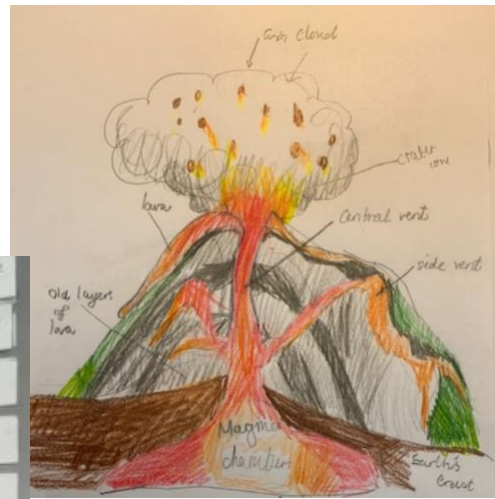


Year 4 Home Learning Week 1
