

Article of the Week - World Religion Day

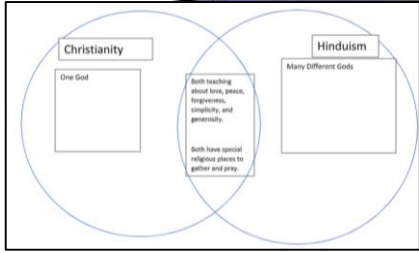
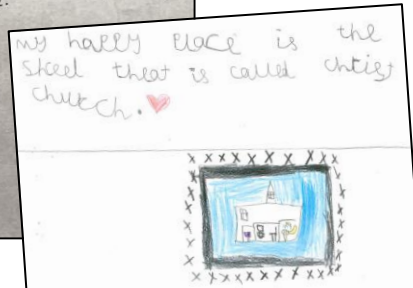
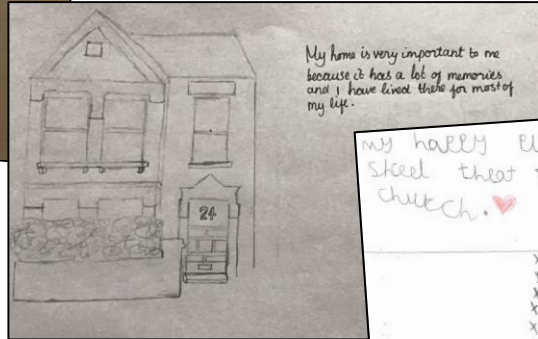
