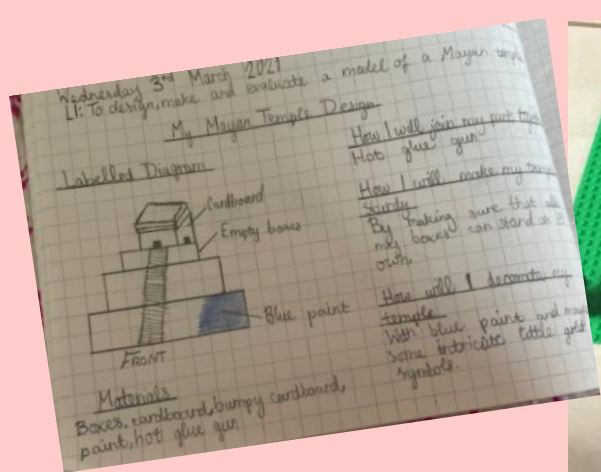


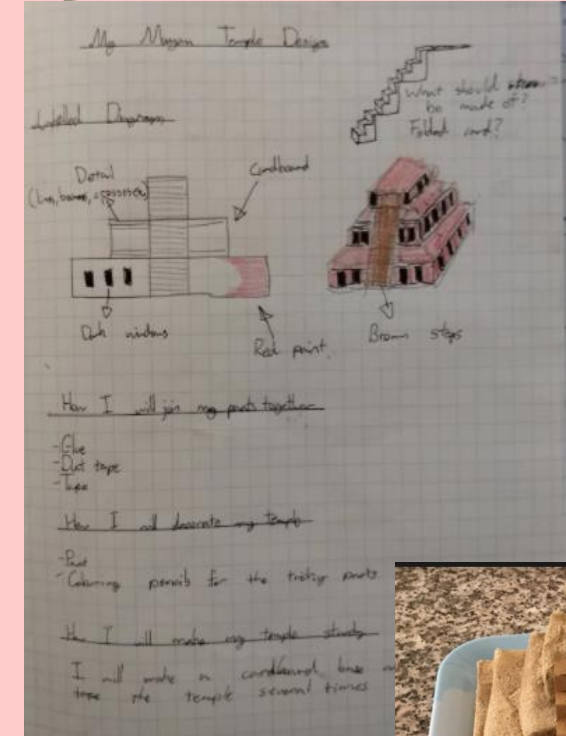
# Mayan Temples!
