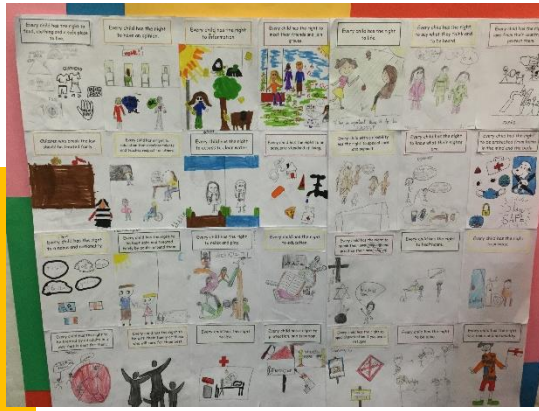
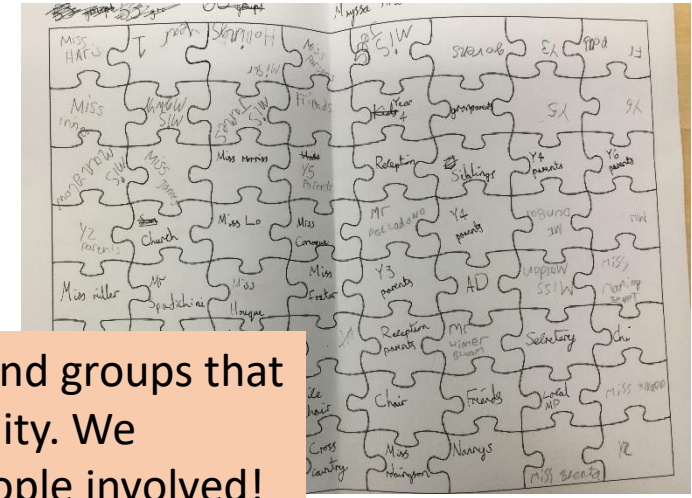


Year 4
PSHE Week learning

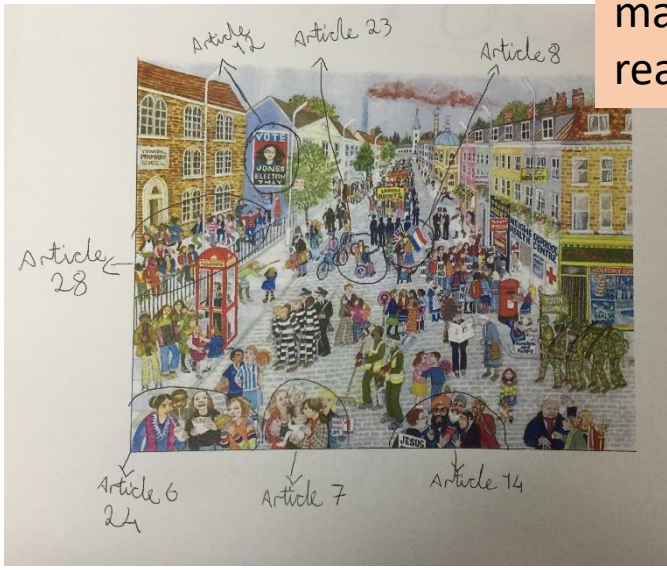

We tried to think of people and groups that make up our school community. We realised there are a lot of people involved!

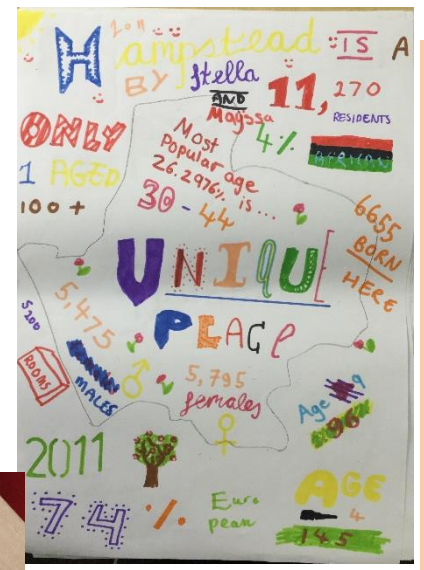


DON'T USE CARS
