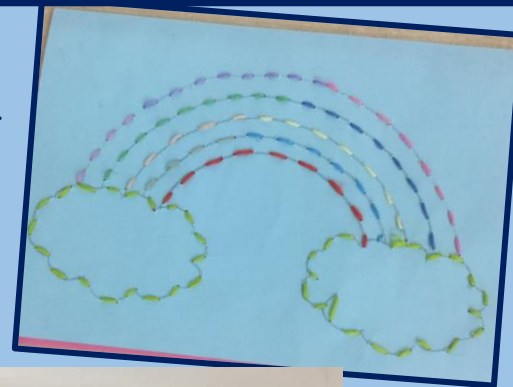



PSHE Week

Year 4 sewed rainbows onto the front of their cards, learning how to successfully do a running stitch.

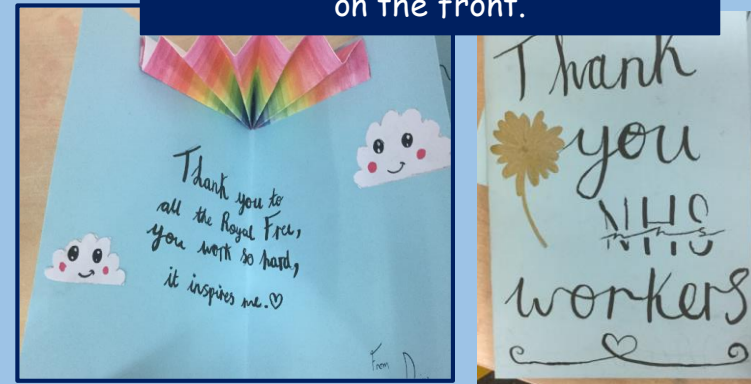


I just wanted to say how grateful we are. You are working so hard so you definitely deserve this card. I hope you have had/will have a great day! Thanks so much!
