Year 4 class trip to Hampstead Heath Education Centre

Year 4 have been learning about Prehistory in our History lessons this term. We visited Hampstead Heath to find out more about how people survived during the Stone Age. The Stone Age spans nearly 2.5 million years and life was very different for the people who lived then!



We started our day by looking at some objects that would have been used in the Stone Age. We looked at a rabbit skin and discussed why this would have been useful. We determined that it would have kept people warm, but also the underside of the skin is waterproof so it would have protected people from harsh weather.

Next we split into two groups and had a go at building shelters and starting fires. These are two ways that people will have survived. We had to work as a team to build a strong structure for our shelters.
