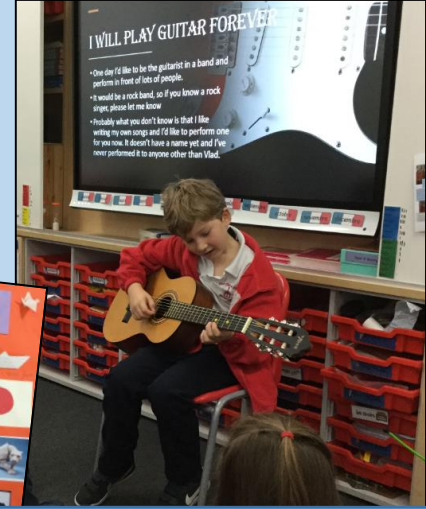
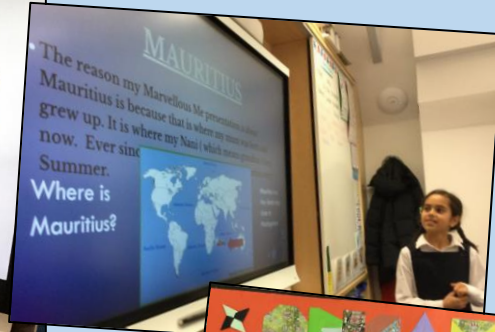
As part of our celebration of our uniqueness and the diversity in our school, each child in Year 1- 6 planned and delivered a 'Marvellous Me' presentation to their class.



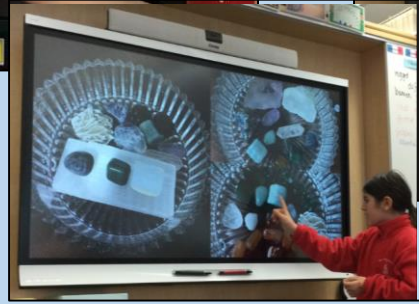
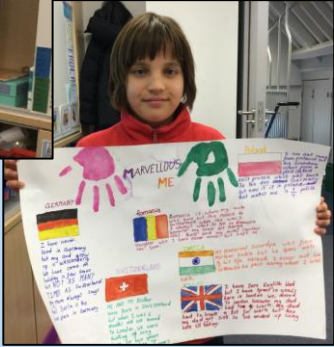
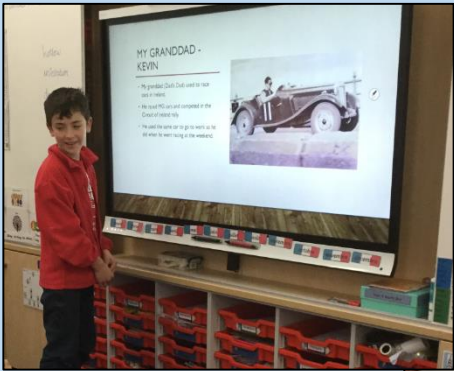
