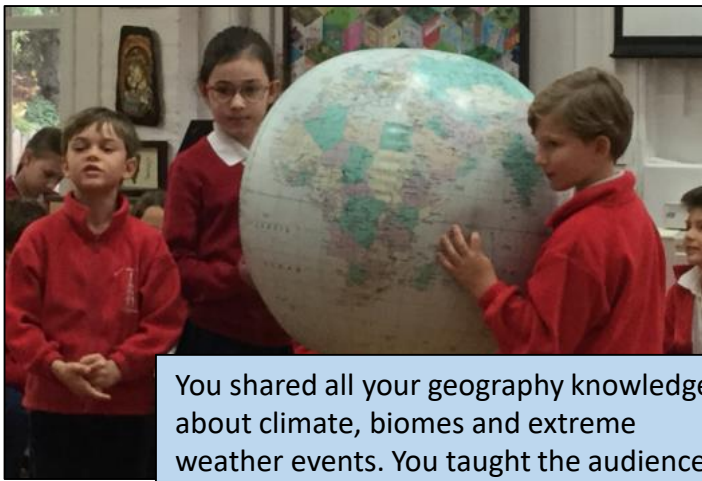


# Fabulous Year 4!
