Years 4 and 5



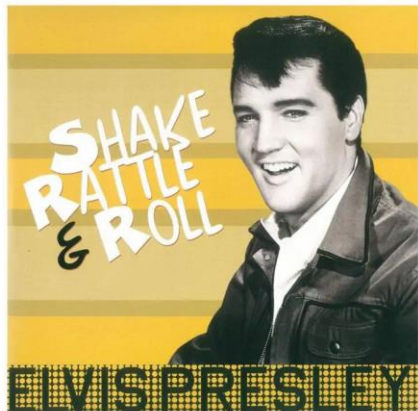
Years 4 and 5 took part in a dance workshop this week! We began by thinking about The Queen's Platinum Jubilee and her coronation in 1953.
