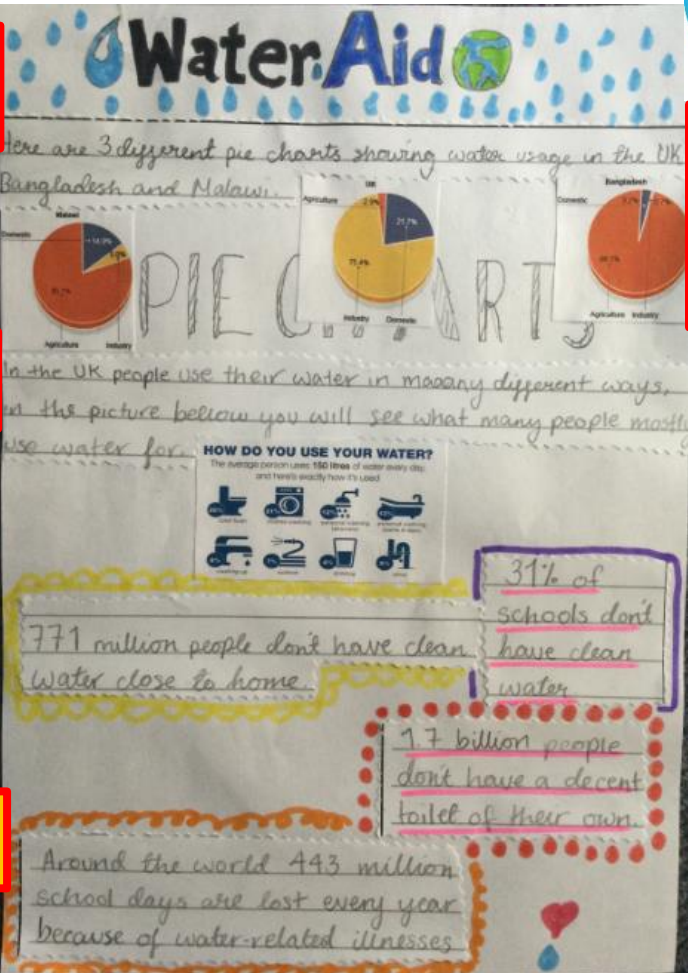
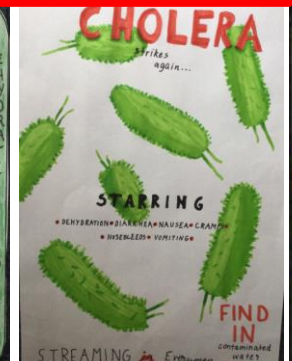
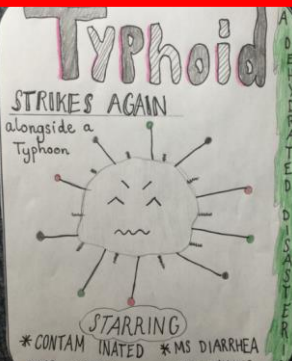
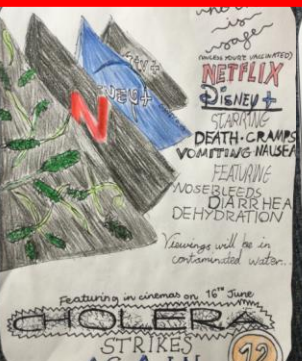


We compared the access and usage of water in more economically developed countries and less economically developed countries and created fact files and leaflets
