What does it mean to be Jewish?

We learnt that the reason Jewish people celebrate **Shabbat** is to remember the **Creation story** where God created the world. A tradition of Shabbat is to eat challah bread. We were lucky enough to bake **challah bread** at the museum. We also learnt traditions that take place at Shabbat including lighting candles and blessing the meals with prayers. We learnt about the **Havdalah (or separation)** from the rest of the week. For this, Jewish people often smell sweet spices. We designed and made our own **Havdalah** spice boxes.
