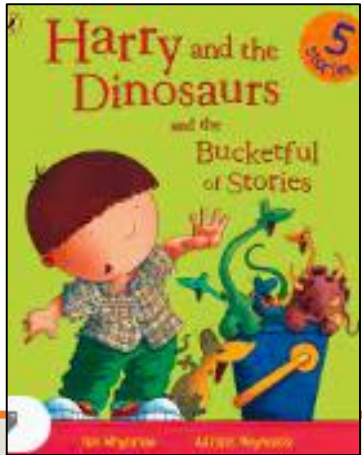


Well done, Year 2, for presenting your learning to us so confidently. You have been learning so much already and you rehearsed and presented your assembly in a very busy week!

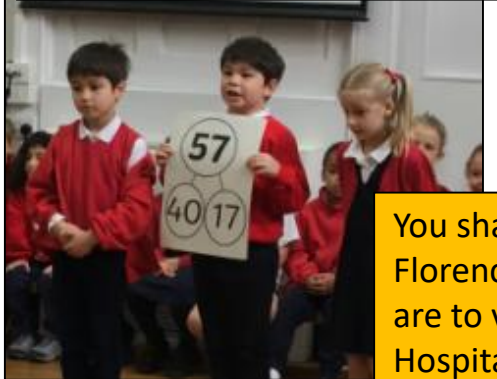
The Beach
