

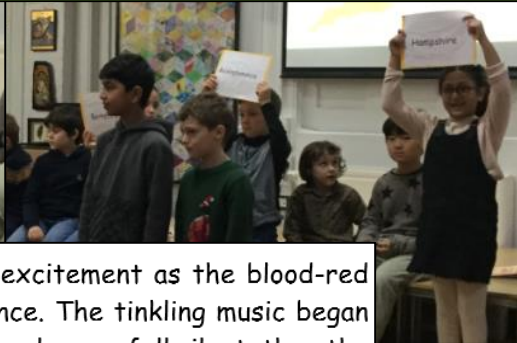
Super assembly, Year 3!
