For our DT project this term, Year 4 thought about researching, designing, making and evaluating our own shell structures to be used as biscuit packaging.

First, we did some market research. We found out about what types of packaging are already used. We looked at some existing packaging and noticed that a lot of boxes are created using a 2D net. We discussed reasons for using different materials and shapes of packaging for different products. We came up with our design criteria as a class.

Laminating - glue together several layers of card Carrugating - xig-xig a piece of paper or card and glue in between two layers of card Ribbing - glue layers of straws between layers of card We decorated our nets with Christmas wrapping paper which we designed, before gluing them together and finishing with ribbon! Then we gave each other feedback of what went well and what we could improve.
