training to achieve them.

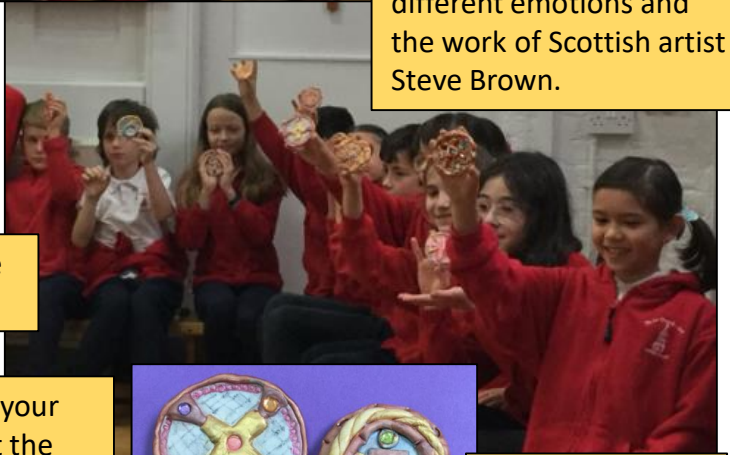


We loved your Highland
