PSHE Week – Summer 2023 Year 2

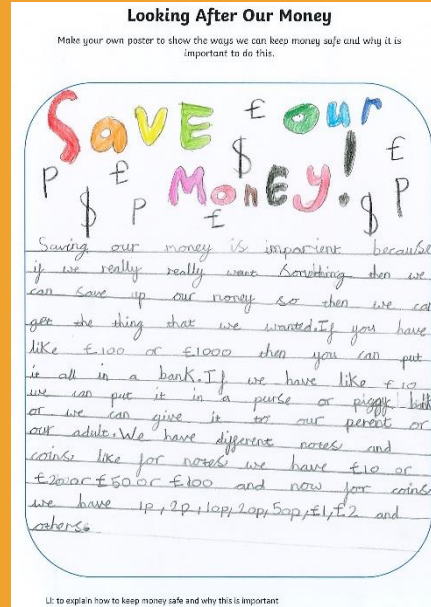

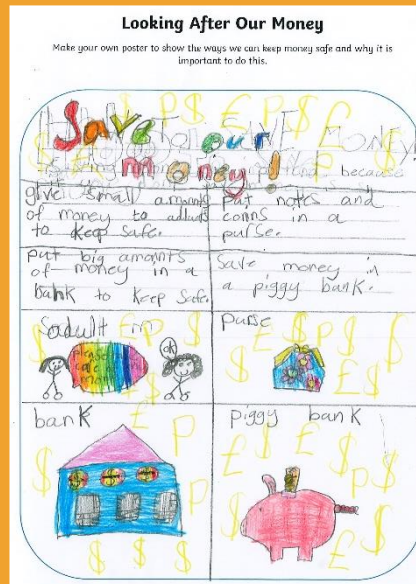


We made posters to explain some of the different ways we can look after money. Some of these include putting it in a purse, bank, or piggy bank, or getting an adult to take care of it for us.
