You presented your learning very clearly and professionally and set a great example as the first class assembly of the summer term!

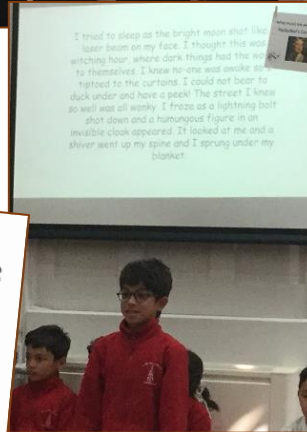
