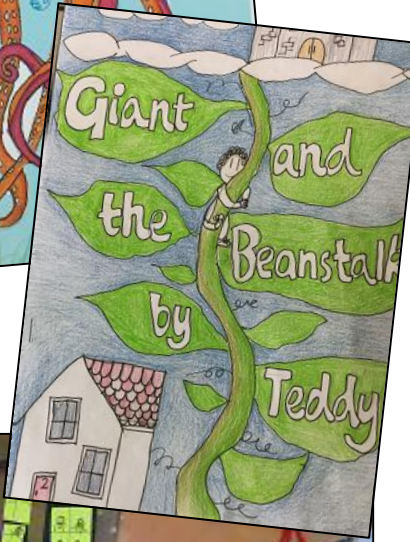


Writing Competition 2023
