Dear parents, carers and families,


It has been a busy half term already with an inspection, the second half of our Happiness Project, a lot of fantastic PSHE and anti-bullying work and a brilliant art exhibition!






At our Christmas events we will be collecting cash donations for

We will be collecting at the infant Nativity play, at the KS2 carol singing on Hampstead High Street and on our Christmas Jumper Day.

Sustainable Christmas

Our children's eco team, the CREW, have been busy reminding us about how to make sure our school Christmas events are as eco-friendly as possible!

- We will be holding a Christmas Jumper swop event after school on Tuesday 5th December. If your child has outgrown their Christmas jumper, please donate it on Monday 4th or Tuesday 5th and we will have jumpers available to take after school on Tuesday in the infant playground. There is no charge, but we will be encouraging donations to our Christmas charities.
- Please make sure your rubbish goes in the correct bin at the Christmas Fair we will be labelling bins for recycling (paper plates, cans, cardboard, glass bottles) and other bins for general waste, including food.
- Try to be sustainable in your choices of gifts to donate for the Fair and the Present Sale donate good-quality second hand gifts if you can and limit single use plastic if possible.





As part of the Celebrating Differences week of our Happiness Project, we heard each child in Years 1-6 share their 'What's special about me' presentation. There were some fascinating and deeply personal presentations about all sorts of things which

make each one of us unique and special. Highlights included presentations about Japanese culture, Arabic heritage, living with coeliac disease, being a citizen of three different nations, being left-handed, being a twin, having an operation and how connections to particular family members are so important to us. It was a very special week - thank you to children for sharing and listening and to parents for supporting with the preparations.

Applications for Reception 2024


