
Hokusai's Great Wave


The image depicts an enormous wave threatening three boats off the coast of the town of Kanagawa (the present-day city of Yokohama) while Mount Fuji rises in the background.



To recreate block printing we traced our cityscape on to a foam 'block'. We used the block to create a black and white print that was then collaged with our great wave.








The children created mono prints of the Great Wave using carbon paper.




Year 4 - Global Goals art work
