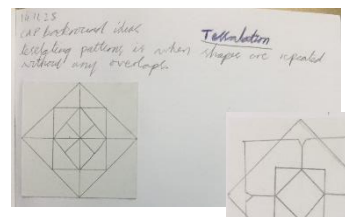


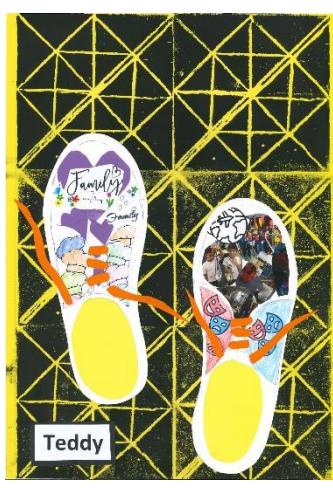
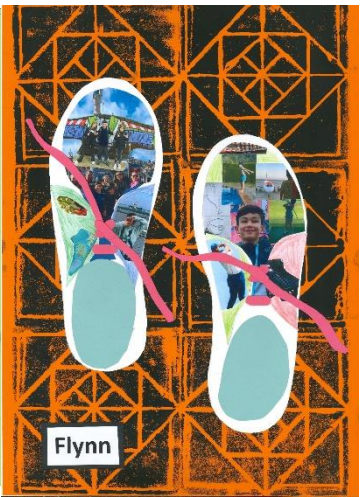
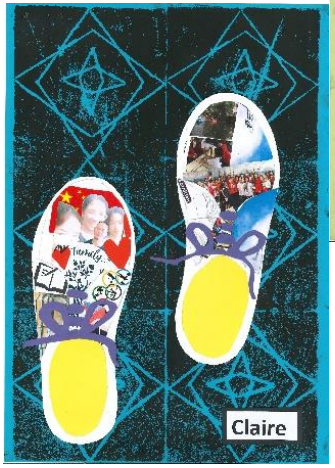
Zughaib's Unfinished Journeys



For our background, we designed our own Arabic-style geometric tile. We had to think carefully about a design that would tessellate.



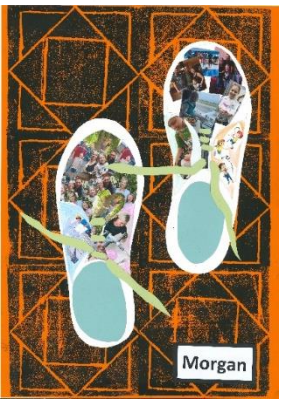
We carved our tile designs into a Styrofoam square to create our block prints.



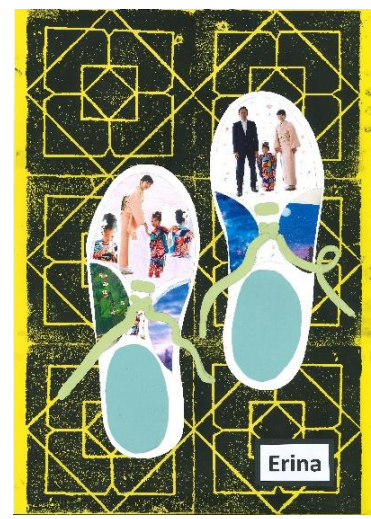
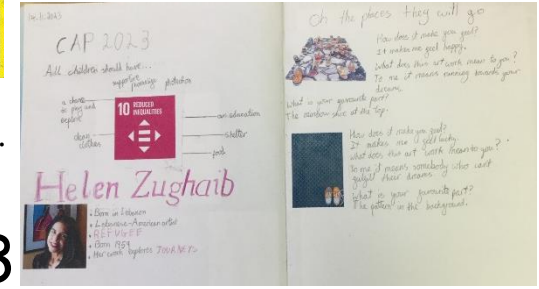
We got in touch with Helen Zughaib to share our work. She was very impressed with our brilliant artwork!
