Information and reminders Staff training and development

Lots of staff training goes on behind the scenes at Christ Church to ensure that teachers are up-to-date with the latest research and have the opportunity to see good practice in action in other schools. For example, teachers attend professional development hubs with teachers from across Camden and further afield – this year these hubs are focusing on provision for pupils with a diagnosis of autism and on the maths mastery approach. Learning from these groups is then shared throughout the staff team. Our teachers also lead and support training for other schools and for trainee teachers as well.

Because of our whole school production at the end of this term, our spring term parents evenings will take place right at the beginning of the summer term on Wednesday 17th and Thursday 18th April.
