

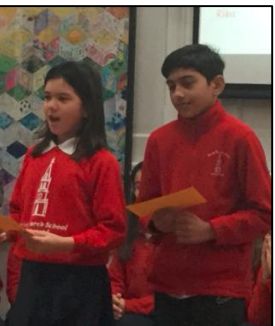
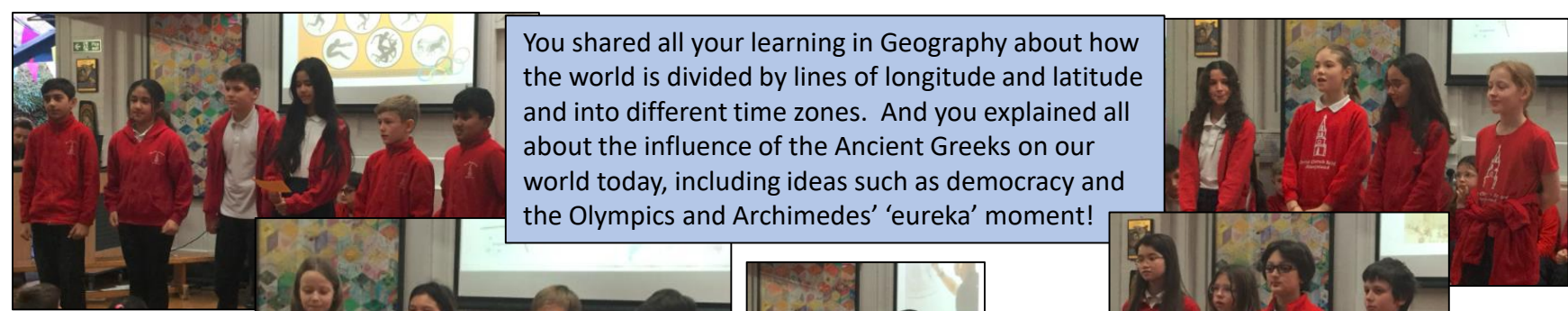
Super assembly, Year 6! Well done!
