
Class assembly

Christ Church Arts Project (CAP) - whole school performance!

This term, we are very excited to be planning a whole school musical production for our Christ Church Arts Project! Every child will be singing and dancing on a big stage in the Church, with music, lights and costumes! There will be lots of hard work and rehearsals over this term as we work together as a whole school on what we hope will be an experience the children will remember forever!



The performances will take place on Thursday 21st March (pm) and Friday 22nd March (evening). More information, including about tickets and how you can help, will be shared with parents soon.



English will cover a range of text types, including biographies and a range of fiction. We will explore devices writers use both to entertain and inform the reader. We will start by exploring figurative language within song lyrics and we will be writing our own song. We will also have a greater emphasis on spelling and grammar this term in preparation for assessments in May.

	body, learning about the circulatory system as well as the effects of diet and		
	exercise on the body. This will link with our PSHE learning this term about		
	healthy bodies. W	e will then move on to learning about light.	
Computing	We will be introd	duced to the creation of websites for a chosen purpose,	
	identifying what makes a good web page and use this information to design		
	and evaluate our own website using Google Sites. We will pay specific		
	attention to copyright and fair use of media, the aesthetics of the site, and		
	navigation paths. We will also be exploring how to keep safe online.		

History	We will be completing our learning about Ancient Greece this term. We will learn about Ancient Greek democracy, architecture and the scientific discoveries of significant individuals like Archimedes. Using all of our learning on how Ancient Greece has influenced the world today, we will be writing a persuasive argument, explaining what we believe to be the greatest influence.
RE	We will be learning about the Buddhist faith this term. We will study what it means to be a Buddhist and explore the importance of the symbols, beliefs and teachings of Buddhism. Our learning at Easter will be focused on the big question, 'How does the Christian festival of Easter offer hope?' We will consider how the Easter story helps Christians to understand forgiveness and how the Easter story relates to God's plan of salvation.
Geography	We will be continuing our learning on how places and people around the world link together this term. We will be learning about migration of people; natural resources, where they come from and how we use them; where water and food comes from; and how we could live more sustainably.
PSHE	In our PSHE week, we will learn about how sleep contributes to a healthy lifestyle; the benefits of sun exposure and risks of overexposure; personal identity and what factors contribute to who we are; the risks and effects of legal drugs common to everyday life; and how to assess the reliability of sources of information online and offline.
PE Tennis Basketball	In the first half of this term, we will be covering Health and Fitness. We will be learning to identify and name specific muscle groups, how to warm them up and how to stretch them. In the second half of this term, we will be developing specific ball skills. We will be exploring a range of more complex technical vocabulary relating to more tactical games and sports in general.
Music	This term the children will be learning the songs for our upcoming whole school production. The children will be continuing their development as singers within a choir with a focus on skills such as breathing techniques, applying accurate and relevant articulation which will enable them to bring the story to life with character and conviction. The children will get the opportunity to showcase their talents in the whole school performance!
Art	In art this term, we will be completing our pottery work linking to the Ancient Greek pottery we will see at the British Museum; we will practise our drawing skills, completing analytical drawings; and we will be considering scale and proportion, inspired by the Pop artist, Roy Lichtenstein.
Design Technology	In design and technology, we will be designing and making nightlights. We will draw on a range of skills and knowledge that we have learnt throughout the school to make a strong and practical shell structure and then a fabric cover for the nightlight.
French	In French, we will combine and consolidate our previous learning about food items and shopping to create menus with descriptions of items on offer and mini role-play scripts related to ordering items in a café and expressing preferences and opinions about food. We will also watch a French play!
